Many patients with with raised blood pressure will not present with symptoms. Raised blood pressure increases the chance of developing cardiovascular disease and contributes to the complications due to type 2 diabetes.

3. How to screen

Blood pressure is measured using a blood pressure machine.

It is important that the blood pressure is taken after the patient has been sitting for 5 minutes.



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
